EB GUIDELINES CHANGES SEASON 2025-26



GAME MANAGEMENT CHANGES

- From the 2025-26 season
 - No verbal warnings or "last chance" signals for behaviour
 - No "warning for flopping" signals
 - Immediate action on disrespect
 - ▼ Technical foul when criteria are met
 - Proactive management without hesitation



GAME MANAGEMENT CHANGES

Warning for Technical foul will remain for:

- Delay of game (Any situation during the game or L2M signal just once)
- Obstructing the vision of a shooter by waving/placing the hand near the opponents' eyes.
- Actions that disconcert an opponent in the act of shooting like shouting loudly, stamping feet heavily or clapping hands close to the shooter's eyes.



GAME MANAGEMENT CHANGES

WHAT CHANGES — AND WHAT DOESN'T

Bench Member Interruption in Fastbreaks/Transitions:

- 1. Entering the court to stop the play → Head coach DISQUALIFIED
- 2. Running sideline to provoke stoppage \rightarrow TF after fastbreak ends (no disadvantage)



IRS CHANGES SEASON 2025-26



IRS CHANGES

- New reviewable matter: 8-second violation
 - Only in the last 2 minutes of Q4 or overtime for referees.
 - Available throughout the game for the coaches.
 - Reviewable only if a call has been made.
- New reviewable matter: Player who committed a foul
 - Available throughout the game for the referees.
 - Not available for the coaches to challenge.
 - This review will be often initiated by the EB headquarters when they identify a clear mistake in the scoresheet with regards to the number of player who committed a foul.
 - Reporting a foul on the wrong player, coach, or team and scorekeeping errors can be corrected at any time during the game (EB casebook).
